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For the Group

Intro

1. Ask everyone in the room to share something they are thankful for.
2. Ask everyone in the room to share something that is bothering them or causing them stress. Pray

Review

1. What was last week's story? How were you obedient to last week's story?
Did you share it with anyone? How did it go?
2. Connect last week's story with this weeks story.

His Story...

1. A) Have the storyteller tell the story. Don't stop and teach. Don't make points. Just tell the story, including as many names and details as possible.
OR
B) Have the facilitator read the story as everyone follows along in their Bibles. Then have everyone close their Bibles and someone reread it and ask everyone to picture themselves there.
2. Have someone tell the story back to the group.
3. Have the group add anything that was added or left out of the story.

Questions

1. What do we learn about God and our relating to Him?
2. What do we learn about people and our relating to them?
3. What questions does this raise for you?
4. What was the main idea of the passage?
5. Challenge the group to obey God's Word. Have each person share what they are going to do to obey the passage over the next week.
6. Have the group identify people they will share the passage with during the next week.

Closing

1. We identified several needs last week and planned to meet those needs. How did it go?
2. Have the group identify people in need and commit to meeting those needs.
3. Close in prayer.
